

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

CALL TO ORDER

Commission Chairman Randy Waldorf called the Butler County Board of Commissioners to order at 6:00 p.m. at the Community Building at 591 SE Rosalia Road in Rosalia. Present were Commissioner Jeff Masterson, Commission Mike Wheeler, Commissioner Dan Woydziak, and Assistant Administrator/Finance Officer Mark Detter. Commissioner Will Carpenter and Administrator William Johnson, Jr., were on vacation.

ITEM #1- CONSIDER APPROVAL OF ACCEPTANCE OF DEDICATIONS FOR DICKINSON ACRES SUBDIVISION.

Chairman Waldorf introduced the item that was tabled at the September 10th, 2007 meeting of the County Commission. Mark Detter displayed the plat to the Commissioners and answered questions.

Commission Woydziak motioned to accept the dedications for the Dickinson Acres Subdivision. Commissioner Masterson seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

ITEM #2- PUBLIC COMMENTS

Charmian Sundgren, President of the Rosalia Senior Center, requested assistance with appropriations for the Rosalia Senior Center. She stated the Senior Center had money left over, but according to the County funding formula for senior centers, they would have to give the money back. Commissioner Woydziak advised Ms. Sundgren to work with Connie Rausch, Aging Director, and Mark Detter to adjust their budget before returning the money.

ITEM #3- ITEMS OF MUTUAL CONCERN BETWEEN BUTLER COUNTY AND THE COMMUNITY OF ROSALIA.

Dean, Jack, and Rene Bender requested an update on the Johnson Salvage Yard in Rosalia. Commissioner Wheeler discussed the current situation and stated that the County was watching the progress closely and was prepared to take action if progress does not continue. Commissioners acknowledged that some progress had occurred on the property, but more clean up was needed. Commissioner Waldorf stated that the goal is to eventually have the entire property clean and the County will continue to work toward that goal.

Jack Bender also requested that Commissioners look at a dangerous structure next to the Rural Water District building in Rosalia. Commissioners agreed to look at the building after the meeting.

No further business came before the Board.

Commissioner Woydziak motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:55 p.m. Commissioner Masterson seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
