The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chairman, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison.

FLOOD PLAIN ZONING AMENDMENT

The Board visited with Mike Bertrand and Jim Schmidt regarding proposed Zoning Regulation amendments.

CELEBRATION FREEDOM

Dick Morris spoke with the Board regarding Celebration Freedom, WW II Memorial project scheduled for November 11, 2000. At 2:00 PM, November 11, 2000 there will be a simultaneous nation-wide balloon release to raise approximately \$5 million to build a memorial in Washington D.C. commemorating the World War II veterans. Mr. Morris is the national chair for the funeral directors involved in the project. Bob Dole is the national chair for the project.

Mr. Morris requested the use of the Community Building April 8 to prepare 22,000 public information kits to send out.

Commissioner Cutsinger moved to authorize the use of the Community Building to waive all fees and the use of County staff to set up tables for the April 8 kit preparation in conjunction with Celebration of Freedom to be held November 11, 2000. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

ADS & ABATES APPROVAL

Commissioner Doll moved to approve Ads totaling \$2,967.13 and Abates totaling \$27,471.78 per approval #2006. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
