

**BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**Tuesday, March 28, 2000**

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chairman, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Commissioner Doll moved to approve the minutes of Monday, March 20 and Tuesday, March 21, 2000 as amended. Commissioner Doll seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**DEPT. ON AGING USED VEHICLE BIDS**

Commissioner Parrish moved to accept the high bid by Charles E. Little for \$1,500 (1983 Dodge), the high bid by Lakepoint Center for \$3,301.99 (1991 Mini Ford Van) and authorize Connie Rausch to continue to work on the sale of the 1988 Ford Van and the 1985 Chevy Wagon. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH AGREEMENT**

Commissioner Parrish moved to approve the contractual agreement between Butler County and HTE, Inc. for Computer Aided Dispatch software as provided for through a federal grant whereby the Federal Government will provide 80% and 20% out of County funds (various departments) and to authorize the Chair to sign. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**RESOLUTION 00-15**

Commissioner Doll moved to adopt Resolution 00-15 (Case RZ-00-03) rezoning land located at 14247 Tawakoni Road, Augusta, Kansas containing 80 acres from Agricultural to Rural Residential. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**CEREAL MALT BEVERAGE LICENSES**

Commissioner Doll moved to approve Cereal Malt Beverage Licenses for Morgan Enterprises, L.C., d.b.a. Shady Creek Marina (not for consumption on the premises) located at the El Dorado Lake and Lori A. Rogers d.b.a. Coin Toss Retreat (not for consumption on the premises) located at 1846 SE Highway 54, El Dorado, Kansas. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITIONS**

Commissioner Doll moved to accept the donation of approximately 6.1 acres of right-of-way on the east side of SW Butler Road just south of Parallel Road from Jason Fog and Candice Orona in exchange for a road entrance. Commissioner seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

Commissioner moved to accept the donation of the approximately 1.52 acre tract of land located on the West side of SW Santa Fe Lake Road approximately 3/8 mile south of SW 170<sup>th</sup> from Robert W. Webb and Golden D. Webb, husband and wife in exchange for a road entrance. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

Commissioner Parrish moved to pass at this time on the KDOT program to upgrade eligible "at grade" railroad crossings to "grade-separated" crossings on certain county roads. Commissioner Doll seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**WATERSHED DETENTION STRUCTURE**

Commissioner Parrish moved to accept an agreement between Butler County and the upper Walnut Watershed Joint District 33 to raise a portion of Stony Creek Road to allow for construction of a proposed watershed detention structure and authorize the Chair to sign when the completed agreement is received for the Watershed District. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**PUBLIC WORKS SOFTWARE UPGRADE**

Commissioner Doll moved to approve the upgrade from a single user license to a network license for Public Works software not to exceed \$5,000 to be paid from budgeted out of Road and Bridge funds. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**DETOUR ROUTE (Upgrade of SW 210<sup>th</sup> and Santa Fe Lake Rd)**

Darryl Lutz, County Engineer reviewed a proposal to upgrade SW 210<sup>th</sup> and Santa Fe Lake Road for a detour route for US Highway 77. Lloyd Howard citizen of rural Douglas area proposed an alternative route that KDOT is studying.

Concerns were shared regarding the detour proposed by KDOT. Mr. Howard said that there is a low water bridge that vehicles have been washed off of on this road. Emergency vehicles, school buses and commuters would be at risk when rains raise the water level.

**ADS AND ABATES APPROVAL**

Commissioner Doll moved to approve Ads and Abates referencing approval number #2008, Ads totaling \$5,271.88 and Abates totaling \$15,552.67. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**ADJOURNMENT**

Commissioner Doll moved to adjourn. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
