

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Tuesday, April 18, 2000

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chairman, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioner Neal Parrish, County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison. Commissioner Linsey Cutsinger was absent.

Commissioner Cutsinger joined the meeting at 9:12 AM.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Parrish moved to approve the minutes of Monday, April 10 and Tuesday, April 11, 2000 as amended. Commissioner Doll seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

DATABASE FOR BUTLER COUNTY REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES

KSU Local Government Specialist, Dr. John Leatherman presented a database of Butler County revenues and expenditures for the period from 1989 through 1998. Dr. Leatherman is working on a database that will contain information from all counties in Kansas. As the database is available, it will be sent to the Butler County Extension Office.

BU CO KDOT AGREEMENT FOR ROADSIDE SPRAYING

Commissioner Doll moved to approve a contractual agreement between The Kansas Department of Transportation and the Butler County Noxious Weed Department for roadside weed spraying and authorize the Chair to sign. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AGREEMENT - DOUGLASS & BU CO

Commissioner Doll moved to approve the contract between Butler County and the City of Douglass for law enforcement services at a rate of \$7,400 per month effective July 1, 2000 and authorize the Chair to sign. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

Commissioner Parrish moved to approve funding revisions to the Juvenile Justice Authority and authorize the Chair to sign. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

ROSE HILL LAND ANNEXATION

Commissioner Doll moved to approve the request from the City of Rose Hill (City Resolution 266) in accordance with K.S.A. 12-520c to annex land generally located at 150th Street south and Rose Hill Road finding it would not hinder or prevent the proper growth and development of the area or any other incorporated city within Butler County. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

COMPOSTING AND WOOD WASTE PROCESSING GRANT

Commissioner Parrish moved to table this Agenda item until Tuesday, April 25, 2000. Commissioner Doll seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

DOUGLASS AVE. PAVING PROJECT AWARD

Commissioner Doll moved to award the contract for the Douglass Avenue paving project for U.S.D. 385/Andover to APAC Kansas, Inc. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

US HWY 54 CONCEPT STUDY

LITTLE WALNUT TWP. RESIGNATION & APPT.

Commissioner Parrish moved to accept the resignation of David Patterson as Little Walnut Township Treasurer and appoint Gary Pickens to the position. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
