

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Monday, May 8, 2000

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chairman, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioner Neal Parrish along with County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison. Commissioner Cutsinger was absent as he was attending the REAP meeting in Wichita.

COUNTY VOUCHER APPROVAL

Commissioner Doll moved to approve County Vouchers totaling \$139,723.35. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 2-0.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

Larry Powell, Butler County Economic Development Director reviewed department activities of the past month. Funding for Economic Development is .5 mils and assessments are issued quarterly.

The Port Authority was briefly discussed. Its priorities were stated as 1) Corridors 2) Water Transportation system for the County 3) Assisting businesses requesting 100 acres plus of land for Industrial Park uses.

Commissioner Doll moved to go into Executive Session until 9:30 AM to discuss corporate financial matters and the acquisition of real estate. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 2-0.
