

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commissioner Chair, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison. County Administrator, Jay Newton was absent.

JAIL / JUDICIAL BUILDING DESIGN DISCUSSION

Dan Rowe of Treanor Architects discussed Jail design change options with the Board to reduce total project cost to \$14 million. The Board directed Mr. Rowe to discuss the project with County Sheriff, Stan Cox to arrive at the total project cost of \$14 million.

The Board directed Mr. Rowe to discuss with the Construction Manager firm, J E Dunn, the Judicial Building design. Total project cost to be \$10 million.

Staying within budget and future expansion were the two main focal points that the Board emphasized as priority.

COUNTY VOUCHER APPROVAL

Commissioner Doll moved to approve County Vouchers dated May 15, 2000 totaling \$342,338.77. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
