

**BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**Monday, July 3, 2000**

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chair, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Commissioner Doll moved to approve the minutes of Monday, June 26 and Tuesday, June 27, 2000. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**COUNTY VOUCHER APPROVAL**

Commissioner Doll moved to approve County Vouchers totaling \$613,567.75. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**KDHE WASTE TIRE AMNESTY PROGRAM**

Solid Waste Director, Diane Rollins presented the upcoming Waste Tire Amnesty Program sponsored by KDHE. The program is limited to waste tires from farms and homes (100 per household) or tires generated by businesses prior to July 1, 1990. This collection is in addition to the annual spring clean-up event. Tires mounted on rims will be accepted.

Commissioner Doll moved to approve the dates for collection of waste tires as a part of KDHE's Waste Tire Amnesty Program as July 22<sup>nd</sup> to August 19<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**AIR CONDITIONER BIDS – COUNTY HIGHWAY SHOP**

Commissioner Parrish moved to approve the bid from Mulvaney Heating and Air Conditioning in an amount not to exceed \$1,766.14 for the County Highway Shop in El Dorado to be paid out of the Road and Bridge Building Improvement fund. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

**SUB DIVISION STREET PAVING POLICY**

County Engineer, Darryl Lutz visited with the Board regarding the development of a county policy for the paving of streets in rural subdivisions in unincorporated areas of Butler County. Mr. Lutz presented results of a survey given to other counties regarding their policies. Sedgwick County leaves the roads on the township system and thereby the townships are responsible for maintenance or contract to have it done. Riley County is considering the County taking over the maintenance. Reno County townships contract with the County. Discussion included road standards and special assessments.

Mr Lutz will develop a policy regarding Sub Division Street Paving.

**STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING – SALVATION ARMY/BU CO**

Commissioner Doll moved to approve the Statement of Understanding between Butler County and the Salvation Army that delineates the responsibility of the Salvation Army in case of disaster in Butler County dated July 3, 2000 and authorize the Chair to sign. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
