

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Monday, July 17, 2000

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chair, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison.

APPROVAL OF VOUCHERS

Commissioner Doll moved to approve County Vouchers totaling \$230,992.02 dated July 17, 2000. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

GREENWOOD COUNTY REQUEST FOR SANITARY CODE SERVICES

County Administrator, Jay Newton presented a request from Greenwood County to contract with Butler County for inspection services on lagoons and sewers. Butler County would charge mileage and an hourly wage. The Board took no action.

FD #1 APPOINTMENTS

Commissioner Doll moved to appoint the following to the Fire District #1 Fire Board: Gary Fugit, to replace Maggie Venema, and Brian Journagen to replace Sonja Moore. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

2000 ELECTION PRIMARY

County Clerk, Mary K. Walker, visited with the Board regarding accusations from Ronald Roberts who is a candidate for County Clerk. She informed the Board that Microvote will be programming the voting machines for the 2000 Election Primary and will be present Election night. She stated that she was making a press release to inform the public of the increased cost of the election to pay for Microvote services. Larry Arnold is a maintenance technician and does not program the machines.

The Commission stated that they had no problem with the way the election is being run based on the advice of the County Attorney's letter.

2001 BUDGET REVIEW

The Commission did a final review on the 2001 County Budget and directed the County Administrator to set the mil at 31.5 mils.
