

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Monday, October 9, 2000

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chairman, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison.

COUNTY VOUCHER APPROVAL

Commissioner Cutsinger moved to approve County Vouchers totaling \$384,178.88 dated October 9, 2000. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

SUBDIVISION ROAD PAVING DISCUSSION WITH TOWNSHIPS

County Engineer, Darryl Lutz stated that currently, the roads in subdivisions developed outside city limits are maintained by the township. The present road standard is gravel. There is no policy for paving of subdivision roads at this time.

Under the proposed policy, an interlocal agreement signed by both the county and the respective township board would authorize the creation of a special improvement district for the subdivision road paving (the township would have the veto power on the policy adoption). The County would construct the roads and the cost of the paving would be paid by those in the subdivision. All of the road maintenance would be the County's responsibility for the life of the road (20 years). One-half of the taxes received by the township would be given to the county for maintenance of the road.

SUBDIVISION ROAD PAVING POLICY ADOPTION

Commissioner Doll moved to adopt the Policy Statement for the creation of Special Paving Improvement Districts for developed subdivisions in Butler County and adopt the Policy for Establishing the Requirements for Paving within Unincorporated Areas of Butler County. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

ROAD IMPACT FEE WAIVER

Commissioner Parrish moved to waive the \$500 Road Impact Fee on property located at 15620 SW Highway 77, owner, Karen Viaz. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

ADJOURNMENT

Commissioner Doll moved to adjourn. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
