

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Monday, September 18, 2000

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chairman, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison.

COUNTY VOUCHER APPROVAL

Commissioner Doll moved to approve County Vouchers dated September 18, 2000 in the amount of \$461,076.28. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

COMMUNICATION TOWER REGULATIONS

Planning and Zoning Director, Mike Bertrand reviewed proposed Communication Tower Regulations with the Board. He presented a map of all existing towers, most of which were located around the cities of Andover and El Dorado and the turnpike. Proposed regulations will be similar to that of Sedgwick County and will be reviewed at a Butler County Planning Board meeting work session. Discussion occurred regarding the removal of towers when no longer in use.

KAC VOTING DELEGATE

Commissioner Doll moved to designate Commissioner Doll as the voting delegate and Neal Parrish and Marcia McCoy as alternates to the Kansas Association of Counties annual meeting. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

ADS AND ABATES APPROVAL

Commissioner Doll moved to approve Ads totaling \$1,245.68 and Abates totaling \$721.29 per approval #2019. Commissioner Parrish seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
