

BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
Monday, September 25, 2000

The Butler County Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commission Chairman, Randy Doll. Present were Commissioners Neal Parrish and Linsey Cutsinger along with County Administrator, Jay Newton and Clerk's Secretary, Tindel Jennison.

COUNTY VOUCHER APPROVAL

Commissioner Doll moved to approve County Vouchers totaling \$374,787.64 dated September 25, 2000. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.

DEPT. ON AGING MATTERS

Connie Rausch visited with the Board regarding the **Physical Fitness Grant** which receives \$6,500 federal money along with a \$765 local match. This grant is primarily for physical fitness classes.

Ms. Rausch presented Senior Center contracts to the Board for their review.

Commissioner Doll moved to approve Ads totaling \$213.54 and Abates totaling \$11,795.90 per approval #2020. Commissioner Cutsinger seconded the motion that carried 3-0.
