

**BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**  
**Tuesday, September 30, 2008**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Commission Chairman Dan Woydziak called the Butler County Board of Commissioners to order at 9:20 a.m. after he and Vice-Commissioner Jeff Masterson welcomed the High School Seniors on the front steps of the Courthouse to Government Day. Present were Commissioner Will Carpenter, Commissioner Randy Waldorf, Commissioner Mike Wheeler, Administrator Will Johnson, Jr., and Clerk Recorder Tammy Bridges.
