From January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017, the Butler County Detention Facility has had one substantiated incident of reported incidents of in custody, sexual abuse or sexual harassment for the entire population of over 200 incarcerated individuals.

Overall, the rate of sexual victimization reported by the incarcerated population of the Butler County Detention Facility is well below the national average. According to the 2012 United States Department of Justice; Bureau of Justice Statistics, the national average for reported in custody sexual victimization is approximately 3.2%.

In 2017, the Butler County Detention Facility continued efforts to maintain compliance with the PREA Detention Standards, to improve the prevention, detection, and response efforts in regards to in-custody sexual victimization. During 2017, the Butler County Detention Facility had one substantiated allegation of inmate to inmate, sexual harassment and zero substantiated allegations of sexual abuse.

- In May of 2017, created standard letter to better comply with PREA standard 115.63 so as reporting allegations of sexual abuse will be reported from agency head to agency head.
- At beginning of 2017, new facility Detective completing all PREA related case investigations. New Detective completed PREA Investigators Training through National Institute of Corrections website in compliance with PREA Training Standard.
- Applied to Department of Justice Certified Auditor Course for 2017, however was not selected due to amount of applicants applied and amount of available auditors in our area of United States.
- Completed PREA Employee Training as well as Ethics for newly hired detention staff, several recertifications' and several road officers who assist at the facility in June and July, 2017.
- Assisted Nursing staff employed at Sumner County Detention by providing copies of Butler County PREA policies to assist that agency in gaining PREA compliance. Also provided training to Sumner County nursing staff concerning PREA Standards.
